Yorta Yorta Aboriginal Corporation (YYNAC) was formed in 1998 to represent the rights and interests of the Yorta Yorta Nation and its members. The organisation is aiming to continue our connection to Yorta Yorta Country and to progress our rights and interests in our cultural identity, social justice, land justice and economic development.

Our organisation is entering an exciting time which includes the formation of a new leadership team. You will lead all the traditional financial elements of the role, but your background means you will bring to the table a broader organisational leadership capability.

Key responsibilities include:

- Provide sound financial support and insights to assist the CEO, advising and implementing best practice methods to manage grant income and expenditure.
- Collaborating with all project managers to drive the annual budgeting process by rigorously reviewing and challenging assumptions.
- Provide financial support for the application and acquittal of funding requests.
- With the support of the external Accountants, monitor, control and report on accurate financial information, including the annual budget, revenue, expenditure and tenders, to meet the needs of external and internal stakeholders and funding bodies.
- Manage and oversee the cash flow of the organisation, ensuring that appropriate financial controls are in place and being adhered to by employees.
- Demonstrate positive and professional leadership which adheres to YYSAC's values and ethics.

As the CFO you will possess:

- Executive level experience in strategic financial management including responsibility for financial and management accounting, revenue operations and the analysis and reporting of organisational performance.
- Successful record in delivering sustainable financial results, involving significant engagement with internal and external parties to the organisation to maximise revenue streams and ensure effective and efficient delivery of services.
- Highly developed communication, interpersonal, and presentation skills with the proven ability to construct and deliver well-argued business cases; consult, negotiate, influence and develop effective relationships.

To be successful in this role you will have Tertiary qualifications in Finance/Accounting and Chartered Accountant (CA) or Certified Practising Accountant (CPA) membership.
