



Culture Heritage Field Representative - Indigenous Identified Position

YYNAC is seeking a Cultural Heritage Field Representative.

This is an “Indigenous Only” role under Special Measures of the EEO Act 2010 Section 12.

This role is responsible for carrying out field-based tasks and other duties as required, including:

- Providing feedback to the Cultural Heritage Unit Manager on resources for Field Representatives, including allocated cultural heritage field tasks, and for consultation purposes.
- Provide information to the Cultural Heritage Unit Manager, Cultural Heritage Officer and Cultural Heritage Team Leader regarding the outcome of fieldwork.
- Liaison with heritage advisors, including anthropologists and archaeologists
- Participation in field assessments including survey, sub-surface testing, cultural heritage protection and management works, inspections and inductions.
- Referral of information to the Cultural Heritage Unit for reporting purposes and to support tasks including responses to land developers, private landowners and public land managers.
- Protect and advocate for the protection of Aboriginal places, objects and Ancestral Remains in accordance with *Aboriginal Heritage Act 2006 (Victoria)* and including as directed by Yorta Yorta Nation Aboriginal Corporation.

To be successful in this role you will have:

- A Certificate IV in Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Management or relevant experience.
- A current Victorian Driver's Licence and Victoria Boat Licence are highly desirable.
- First Aid Level 1
